The COVID-19 pandemic has hit the Outer Boroughs really hard, and stretched its frontline and safety net hospitals to the limit.

IS THIS FAIR?

- Manhattan has 1.6 million residents, 21 hospitals, and 6.4 hospital beds per 1,000 people.
- Meanwhile, Queens has 1.5 beds, Brooklyn 2.2 beds, Staten Island 2.5 beds, and Brooklyn 2.7 beds per resident. The national average is 2.9 beds per capita.
- Northwell Health wants to build a luxury tower with more beds to replace Lenox Hill Hospital.
