## Impact of federal threats to health care on New York State:



#### 1.5 million New Yorkers would lose health coverage



1,241,000 were previously enrolled in Medicaid 224,000 were previously enrolled in the Essential Plan



### The State would lose \$13.5 billion annually

from the loss of federal funding and shifted costs to the State to keep New Yorkers covered



New York Hospitals will lose \$3.2 billion annually from reduced reimbursements and uncompensated care losses

# Impact of federal threats to health care on New Yorkers living in Congressional District 9:



73,300 on Medicaid will become uninsured

18% of the 404,500 constituents currently on Medicaid

15,200 on the Essential Plan will become uninsured 12% of the 123,800 constituents currently on the Essential Plan



Cuts will cause District 9 to lose \$881 million annually in funding

Hospitals in this district will also lose \$253 million annually in funding
