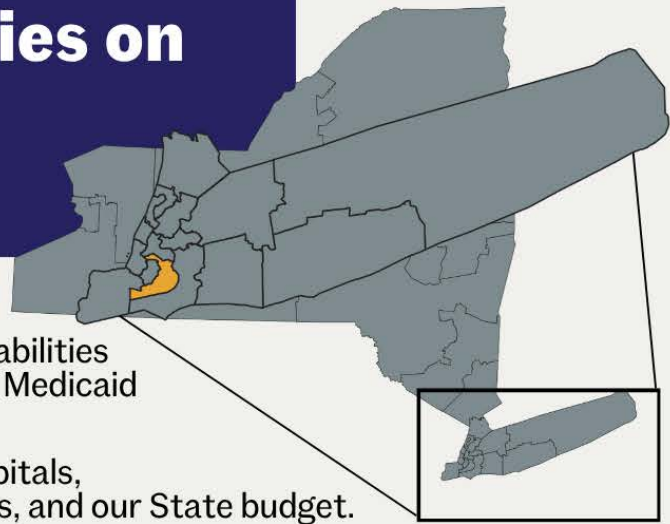


# The impact of federal policies on New Yorkers and the State's health care system

## Nearly 8.6 million New Yorkers

including seniors, children, pregnant people, people with disabilities and low- and moderate-wage and part-time workers rely on Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act for their health care.

Federal cuts to health care will devastate New Yorkers, hospitals, health care providers, insurance companies, local economies, and our State budget.



## Impact of federal threats to health care on New York State:



**COVERAGE  
LOSSES**

**1.7 million New Yorkers will lose their current health coverage**



**1,241,000** currently enrolled in Medicaid

**464,000** currently enrolled in the Essential Plan

## Impact on Congressional District 8:



**INCREASED  
PREMIUMS +  
COVERAGE  
LOSS**

**67,700 on Medicaid may become uninsured**

**19%** of the **358,300** constituents currently on Medicaid

**23,000 on the Essential Plan may become uninsured**

If Congress does not extend premium tax credits set to expire next year, premiums on the NYSOH marketplace will increase by

**50%, or \$2,850/year for a couple**



**FUNDING  
CUTS**

**Cuts will cause District 8 to lose \$665 million**

Hospitals in this district will also lose **\$40 million**

which may force rural or safety-net hospitals to close
